RULES

PLEASE NOTE: This is a large event with high attendance. For the convenience, safety and enjoyment of all, we ask that you comply with the following rules:

1. Hours are Friday 4 p.m. to 9 p.m., Saturday 10 a.m. to 9 p.m., and Sunday 10 a.m. until 8 p.m. This is an outdoor show. There will be no early tear down due to inclement weather. Early tear down will result in not being invited to return next year. In order to ensure the safety of customers and spectators, no cars will be allowed into the show area Sunday night until it is clear of foot traffic as determined by the Howell Police Department.
2. Vendors will be allowed to drive their vehicles up to their booths during set-up and breakdown times ONLY. At all other times, vehicles must remain in designated parking areas. VENDORS MAY NOT PARK THEIR CARS BY THEIR BOOTHS. Handicapped vendors may use the designated handicapped parking area only if their cars are properly marked with handicapped identification.
3. Set-up time will be assigned by the Michigan Challenge committee and will be indicated on the confirmation. Vendors arriving late for their set-up time should expect to wait before bringing their vehicles to their booth. Vendors arriving after 4 p.m. on Friday may be denied entrance to the show.
4. Vendors will receive a map showing booth location with confirmation. To access parking during the show, use the Grand River entrance. The event is located at the Howell High School complex, 1200 W. Grand River.
5. Booth size is 10 ft. x 10 ft., you cannot extend beyond your assigned space(s). Vendors located on asphalt may not drive stakes into the asphalt. Weighted anchors are recommended.
6. THE USE OF GENERATORS IS NOT ALLOWED AT THIS SHOW. ELECTRICITY IS NOT AVAILABLE. Exhibitors will provide their own tables, chairs and rack covers in the event of rain. Canopies are recommended. Vendors may not drive canopy stakes into the asphalt. Weighted anchors are recommended. Porta-Johns are located nearby. There are limited hand-washing facilities. The school buildings are closed to both the general public and vendors.
7. ITEMS SOLD WILL BE ENTERED TO JURY FOR JUDGING. NO TOY OR REAL WEAPONS, YOYO BALLOONS, FOOD, MARSHMALLOW GUNS, DRUG PARAPHERNALIA , ALCOHOL-RELATED ITEMS OR ANY ITEMS DEEMED OBJECTIONABLE TO THE COMMITTEE MAY BE SOLD.
8. All booths are assigned by the balloonfest committee. All booths must be removed by midnight Sunday.
9. We require all our exhibitors to carry liability insurance. A certificate naming the Howell Area Chamber of Commerce as additional insured up to \$1 million must be provided.
10. Application checks or credit card charges will not be processed until the vendor is accepted into the show. The last day for cancellations by vendors will be April 17, 2020. Refunds for any reason will not be made after this date.
11. Uniformed security will be provided overnight at the balloonfest site. However, displays left overnight are done so at the vendor's own risk.
12. Trash receptacles located throughout the show are for the convenience of the attendees and may not be brought into booths.

Failure to comply with these rules may result in being asked to leave
and not being invited to participate in this show again.
